

## Making The Word of God Final Authority In Our Life

The Word of God should be the only authority we base our life on as the body of Christ.

We base our outcome not by what we see in the natural, but by the Spirit by faith and we confess what we want to see based on the Word of God.

If it's not based on the Word of God then it shouldn't be in our confession.

Jesus only said what He heard the Father say and did only what the Father said to do.

**John 5:19 (KJV)** Then answered Jesus and said unto them, *Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.*

**John 12:49** *For I have not spoken of myself; but the Father which sent me, he gave me a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak.*

**John 12:50** *And I know that his commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto me, so I speak.*

*It's not the outcome of pleasing the ourselves (the flesh) or pleasing others. It's the outcome of pleasing God, the Father.*

**Proverbs 4:20 (KJV)** My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings.

**Proverbs 4:21** Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart.

**Proverbs 4:22** For they *are* life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.

**Proverbs 4:23** Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it *are* the issues of life.

**Proverbs 4:20 (AMP)** My son, attend to my words; consent *and* submit to my sayings.

**Proverbs 4:21** Let them not depart from your sight; keep them in the center of your heart.

**Proverbs 4:22** For they *are* life to those who find them, healing *and* health to all their flesh.

**Proverbs 4:23** Keep *and* guard your heart with all vigilance *and* above all that you guard, for out of it flow the springs of life.

*As we read His Word and read it out loud to where we can hear it, it increases our faith.*

**Romans 10:17** So then faith *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

## **We need the knowledge of the Word**

*When we read the Word, we receive knowledge of what it says.*

**Hosea 4:6** My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.

*When we study the Word of God, He ministers to us what we need to know.*

**2 Timothy 2:15** Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

***Rightly dividing is to dissect (expound) correctly (the divine message): - rightly divide.***

**2 Timothy 2:15 (AMP)** Study and be eager and do your utmost to present yourself to God approved (tested by trial), a workman who has no cause to be ashamed, correctly analyzing and accurately dividing [rightly handling and skillfully teaching] the Word of Truth.

*It is good to pray before reading and thank the Father for the revelation, knowledge and understanding of His Word.*

**Colossians 1:9** For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding;

**Colossians 1:10** That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God;

**Colossians 1:9 (AMP)** For this reason we also, from the day we heard of it, have not ceased to pray and make [special] request for you, [asking] that you may be filled with the full (deep and clear) knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom [in comprehensive insight into the ways and purposes of God] and in understanding and discernment of spiritual things—

**Colossians 1:9** That you may walk (live and conduct yourselves) in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to Him and desiring to please Him in all things, bearing fruit in every good work and steadily growing and increasing in and by the knowledge of God [with fuller, deeper, and clearer insight, acquaintance, and recognition].

## **Our spirit man needs the Word of God.**

*When we neglect our spirit man the feeding of the Word of God, we neglect our natural man the manifestation of the Word of God.*

## **The Word of God can transform us by the renewing of our mind.**

**Romans 12:2 (KJV)** And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

**Romans 12:2 (AMP)** Do not be conformed to this world (this age), [fashioned after and adapted to its external, superficial customs], but be transformed (changed) by the [entire] renewal of your mind [by its new ideals and its new attitude], so that you may prove [for yourselves] what is the good and acceptable and perfect will of God, *even* the thing which is good and acceptable and perfect [in His sight for you].

**God wants us blessed and prosperous.**

**He wants us to succeed. He will reveal to us what we need to know.**

**Jeremiah 29:11 (KJV)** For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.

**Jeremiah 29:11 (AMP)** For I know the thoughts and plans that I have for you, says the Lord, thoughts and plans for welfare and peace and not for evil, to give you hope in your final outcome.

**Deuteronomy 30:19-20 (KJV)**

19 I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live:

20 That thou mayest love the LORD thy God, and that thou mayest obey his voice, and that thou mayest cleave unto him: for he is thy life, and the length of thy days: that thou mayest dwell in the land which the LORD sware unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them.

**Deuteronomy 28:1-14 (KJV)**

1 And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the LORD thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth:

2 And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God.

**Deuteronomy 28:1-2 (AMP)**

1 IF YOU will listen diligently to the voice of the Lord your God, being watchful to do all His commandments which I command you this day, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth.

2 And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you if you heed the voice of the Lord your God.

**Deuteronomy 28:3 (KJV)** Blessed shalt thou be in the city, and blessed shalt thou be in the field.

4 Blessed shall be the fruit of thy body, and the fruit of thy ground, and the fruit of thy cattle, the increase of thy kine, and the flocks of thy sheep.

5 Blessed shall be thy basket and thy store.

6 Blessed shalt thou be when thou comest in, and blessed shalt thou be when thou goest out.

7 The LORD shall cause thine enemies that rise up against thee to be smitten before thy face: they shall come out against thee one way, and flee before thee seven ways.

8 The LORD shall command the blessing upon thee in thy storehouses, and in all that thou settest thine hand unto; and he shall bless thee in the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

9 The LORD shall establish thee an holy people unto himself, as he hath sworn unto thee, if thou shalt keep the commandments of the LORD thy God, and walk in his ways.

10 And all people of the earth shall see that thou art called by the name of the LORD; and they shall be afraid of thee.

11 And the LORD shall make thee plenteous in goods, in the fruit of thy body, and in the fruit of thy cattle, and in the fruit of thy ground, in the land which the LORD sware unto thy fathers to give thee.

12 The LORD shall open unto thee his good treasure, the heaven to give the rain unto thy land in his season, and to bless all the work of thine hand: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow.

13 And the LORD shall make thee the head, and not the tail; and thou shalt be above only, and thou shalt not be beneath; if that thou hearken unto the commandments of the LORD thy God, which I command thee this day, to observe and to do them:

14 And thou shalt not go aside from any of the words which I command thee this day, to the right hand, or to the left, to go after other gods to serve them.

### **We need the Word of God to take place in our life.**

In order for the Word to take place, our confession has to be in line with His Word.

Confession brings possession.

As we sow the Word into our heart, we will be able to speak (confess) the Word by faith and see it manifest.

We need to stay committed to Father and His Word. Because if we lack commitment, we lack fulfillment.

### **Staying focused on the Answer.**

If we are focused on the problem, then we are not focused on the Word of God. Which is the answer.

We need to look towards what glorifies the Father, which is to focus on His Word and be a doer of His Word and not a hearer only

**James 1:22 (KJV)** But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.

**James 1:22 (AMP)** But be doers of the Word [obey the message], and not merely listeners to it, betraying yourselves [into deception by reasoning contrary to the Truth].

### **We are Victorious!**

**1 Corinthians 15:57 (KJV)** But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

**1 Corinthians 15:57 AMP** But thanks be to God, Who gives us the victory [making us conquerors] through our Lord Jesus Christ.
