

The Value Of The Word Of God.

Proverbs 4:20 (KJV) My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings.

Attend: Hebrew: to prick up the ears, that is, hearken: - attend, (cause to) hear (-ken), give heed, incline, mark (well), regard.

Incline: Hebrew: cause to yield.

Proverbs 4:21-24 (KJV)

21 Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart.

22 For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.

23 Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.

24 Put away from thee a froward mouth, and perverse lips put far from thee.

As we attend to and hear God's Word and incline or yield our ears to His sayings, which when we speak the Word while we read it will increase our faith.

Romans 10:17 (KJV) So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.

When we read the word out loud, we hear it and our faith will increase.

When we value the Word of God, it becomes more valuable to us and we want to get into the Word more and more. We will get to where we can't wait to read the Word.

Our Confession.

We need to value the words that we speak. As the body of Christ especially, we have authority behind our words. As we speak God's Word and we declare it in Jesus name, we speak it with His authority and we see it take place.

When we spend time in the Word daily, we start to watch our confession because we realize we want the right things to take place in our life.

We don't want to speak negative words and see negative results take place.

We can change the atmosphere around us whether there are people around us or if we are alone.

Proverbs 18:21 (KJV) Death and life *are* in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

We need to speak life.

Renewing Our Mind.

Romans 12:2 (KJV) And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Renewing: Greek: *renovation*: - renewing.

To Prove: Greek: to *test*, by implication to *approve*: - allow, discern, examine, prove, try.

When we renew our mind with the Word of God, we get our minds clear from worldly thoughts and put the Word of God in our mind and in our heart, then we will notice and hear our confession change and become based on the Word of God.

Putting The Word In Our Heart.

Matthew 12:34 (KJV) O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh.

Matthew 12:34 (AMP) You offspring of vipers! How can you speak good things when you are evil (wicked)? For out of the fullness (the overflow, the superabundance) of the heart the mouth speaks.

Luke 6:45 (KJV) A good man out of the good treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is evil: for of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaketh.

What we put in our heart comes out of our mouth.

God watches over His Word to perform it.

Jeremiah 1:12 (KJV) Then said the LORD unto me, Thou hast well seen: for I will hasten my word to perform it.

Hasten: Hebrew: to be alert, sleepless; hence to be on the lookout (whether for good or ill): - hasten, remain, wake, watch (for).

Jeremiah 1:12 (AMP) Then said the Lord to me, You have seen well, for I am alert and active, watching over My word to perform it.

His Word will not come back to Him void.

Isaiah 55:11 (KJV) So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.

Isaiah 55:11 (AMP) So shall My word be that goes forth out of My mouth: it shall not return to Me void [without producing any effect, useless], but it shall accomplish that which I please and purpose, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.

As we speak His Word, it will not return void.

We speak His Word by faith, we will see it manifest.

We speak the Word over our body.
